Executive Summary

Since 1982, tips coming in over the Safe City Commission Crime Stoppers Tip Line have resulted in excess of **\$1,388,000.00** in rewards being paid to anonymous tipsters. These tips resulted in the recovery of over **\$27,310,000.00** worth of stolen property and narcotics, over **6,400** law breaking individuals being arrested, and over **10,600** cases being cleared.

The Safe City Commission Crime Stoppers Program has two operational divisions. Collectively, in 2006 these divisions paid **\$76,200.00** in rewards. These rewards helped effect the recovery of **\$224,812.00** in stolen property and narcotics, the arrest of **276** individuals, and the clearing of **573** cases.

The Community Program – 2006

Countywide, we assisted in the recovery of stolen property and narcotics valued at **\$218,142.00**. In addition, **174** arrests were made, **377** cases were cleared, and **\$68,300.00** in rewards was paid in 2006.

The Campus Program - 2006

Rewards for the Campus Crime Stoppers Program totaled **\$7,900.00**, with **\$6,670.00** in stolen property and narcotics being recovered, **102** individuals arrested, **162** administratively disciplined, and **196** cases cleared on our local school campuses.

Mission Statement

The Safe City Commission Crime Stoppers program is a non-profit organization dedicated to solving the unsolvable crimes in our community. The organization is a cooperative effort between the citizens of Tarrant County, local law enforcement agencies, and the local media of the metroplex. The goal is to generate anonymous tips from the community which will solve felony crimes, apprehend wanted felons, and make our community a safer place.

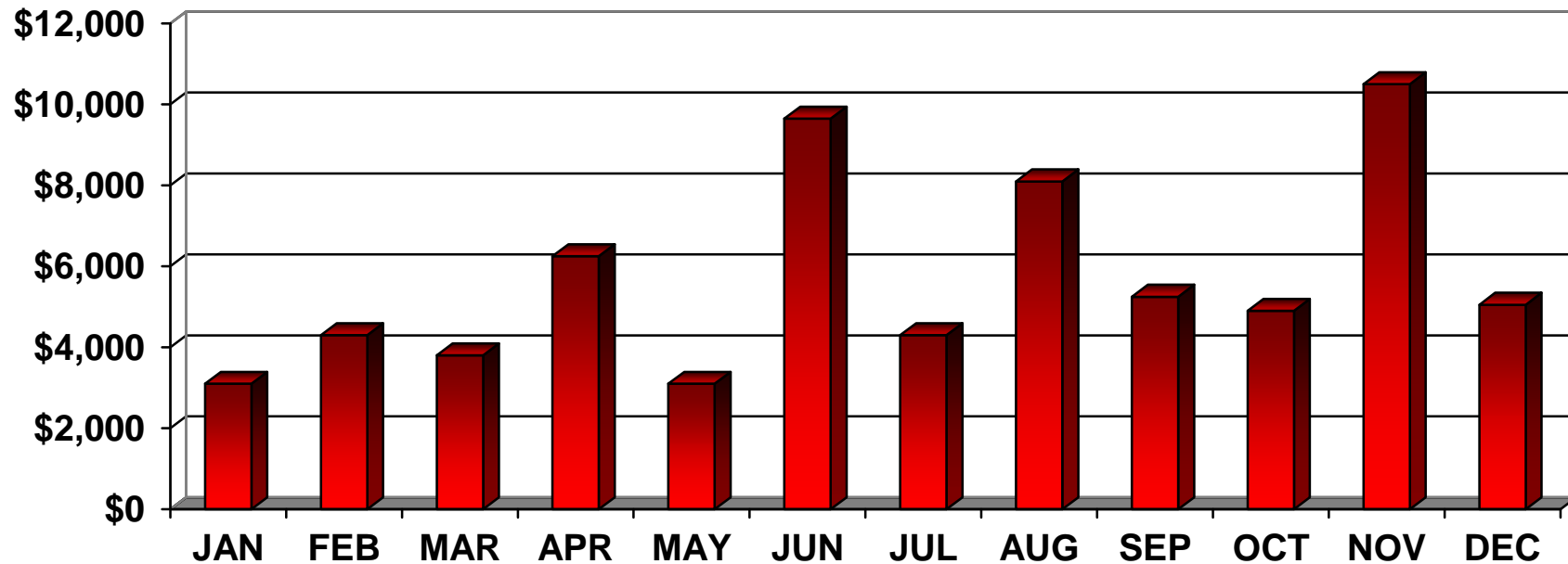

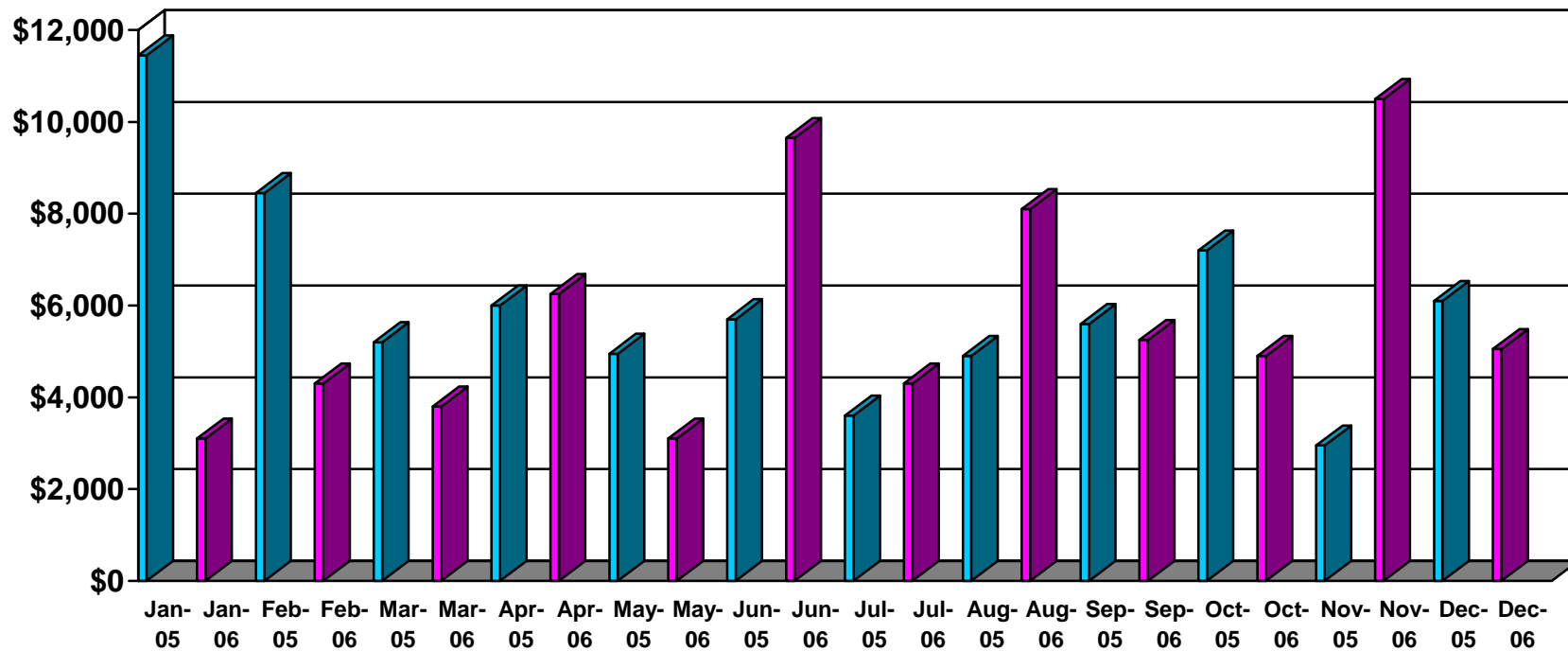

MONIES AWARDED 2005/2006 COMPARISON



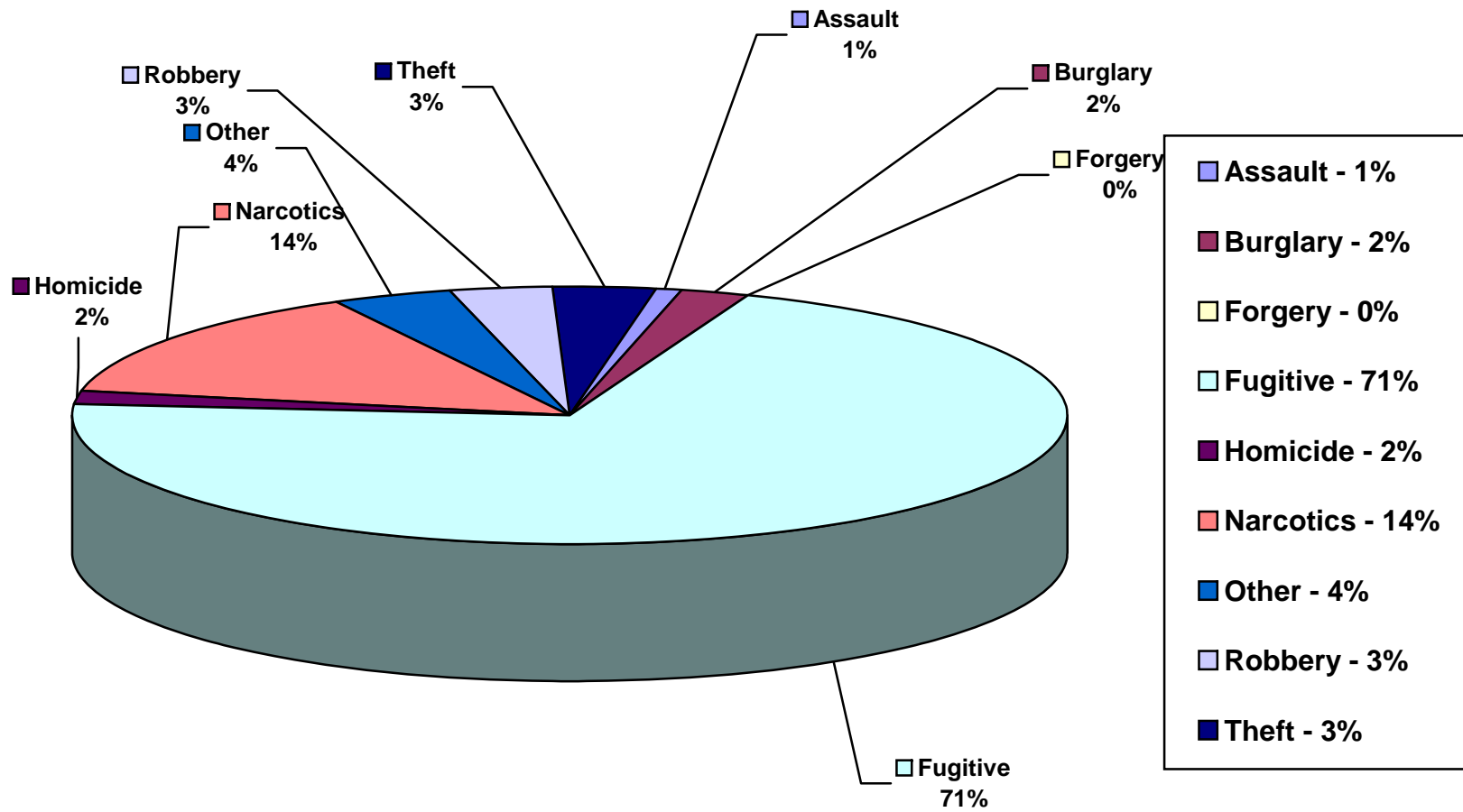
